

In keeping with School Smarts' operating principle of inclusion, the program and curricula is offered in the six languages most spoken in California: English, Spanish, Arabic, Chinese, Tagalog and Vietnamese.

Did you know...

- 73 percent of School Smarts graduates speak a language other than English at home
- 31 percent of School Smarts graduates did not complete high school
- 88 percent of School Smarts graduates are female and 12 percent are male
- 84 percent of School Smarts graduates are mothers, 12 percent are fathers, 3 percent are grandparents and 1 percent are other caregivers.
