IMPORTANT JANUARY UPDATES

Congratulations! You made it through the first part of the school year and your PTA term of office. Here are a few reminders of "To Do's" for this month.



AUDITS: January is the month for our mid-year audits. Please review the audit requirements in our <u>five-part blog series</u>. Reach out to your Council or District auditors if you have any questions.

INSURANCE: Our new insurance year started on January 5th. If you have not received your insurance guide, there is one available on our website.

WORKERS COMPENSATION REPORTS: Your workers compensation report is due to California State PTA, through channels, by January 31st. If you have not submitted yours yet, please fill it out and submit before the end of the month. <u>Click here</u> for full details about the report.

NOMINATING COMMITTEES AND ELECTIONS: Now is the time to elect your nominating committees for elections this year. Our council and units are required to hold election meetings every year, before the second week of April

The "Nom Com" is responsible for putting together a list of officers for the new term. Check your bylaws and the CAPTA Toolkit for guidelines on the <u>nominating process</u> and <u>holding elections</u>.

HISTORIAN HOURS: Just a quick reminder that your historian should be tallying volunteer hours every month in preparation for the Annual Historian Report due in May. Here is a great <u>tally form</u> to get you started. Check with your council or district for the actual due date of the report.

MEMBERSHIP: Remember, membership is a full year activity. Please encourage your parents and supporters to join your PTA at every event you host.

A question that has come up a few times this year is "if I enter members into the TOTEM system who did not join electronically, do I still need to forward those membership dues?" The answer is yes. While entering members that

joined by cash or check into the TOTEM system can give you a great membership list, it does not move those memberships forward to the council, district, or state levels. So please make sure those memberships are turned in.

GRADUATING SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE FAST APPROACHING!

Did you know that California State PTA offers scholarships for graduating seniors? If you know a student who might be interested, act fast, because the application deadline is **February 1**!

Two scholarships are available:

- \$750 Volunteer Service Scholarship This scholarship recognizes graduating seniors for their volunteer service in schools and communities, allowing them to register for courses at accredited colleges, universities, trade or technical schools.
 Applicants must be PTA members graduating from a California high school between January 1 and June 30 of the current academic year.
- \$500 Dr. Ralph E. White Graduating Senior Scholarship Honoring the volunteer and public-service legacy of Dr. Ralph E. White and his wife, Eleanor, this additional scholarship provides \$500 each to two successful applicants of the Volunteer Service Scholarship who intend to pursue a career in a medical field.
