Class Descriptions

PRESIDENT (101 and 201)

A great class for beginning leaders as well as seasoned pros. Learn what every president needs to know, as well as tips from other leaders. This class runs two sessions – 1 and 2.

TREASURER (102 and 202)

Perfect for beginning and experienced treasurers. Learn the ins and outs of being a PTA treasurer. In this class, we will go over financial requirements to keep your unit in good standing with PTA and various governmental agencies. This class runs two sessions – 1 and 2.

MEMBERSHIP (103)

Membership is an important part of every PTA. Find out about all the great tools California State PTA has for our units to promote and increase membership.

COMMUNICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA (104)

Communication is a vital cog in the PTA machine. Today, social media is one of the most effective communication tools that you can use to reach PTA leaders and members. Learn how to target your audience, prepare your message and choose the appropriate method of delivery. Learn basic social media skills to promote your PTA programs and communicate with your school community. FUNDRAISING (204)

Fundraising is a major part of any PTA. Understand the rules and guidelines set forth to keep your PTA unit on the right side.

LEGISLATION (105)

Join our legislation team as we cover a wide variety of topics including local advocacy, supporting our students and LCAP. Learn how to use social media to advocate for our kids. The latest and hottest legislative topics coming out of Sacramento and Washington will also be covered.

SECRETARY (206)

PTA minutes are important. Learn about your duties to the board and what needs to be included in your monthly minutes. Also, learn about new changes that are coming forward from California State PTA.

COUNCIL LEADERS – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW (207)

PTA 411 (301)

UNDERSTANDING CULTURE TO RECRUIT AND RETAIN A DIVERSE BOARD (304)

How does the diversity of cultures impact your PTA? Join the discussion as we define culture as it relates to PTA and identify how culture plays a role in your PTA, while you build understanding of cultural diversity to recruit and retain a diverse board.

HOT TOPICS IN HEALTH & COMMUNITY CONCERNS (305)

Come hear about what is going on currently in the subjects of health and community concerns. How serious is the opioid crisis? Learn about our allied agencies in the areas of teen drug and alcohol use prevention, bullying, health care information for families and safe teen driving. BYLAWS & E-BYLAWS (306)
