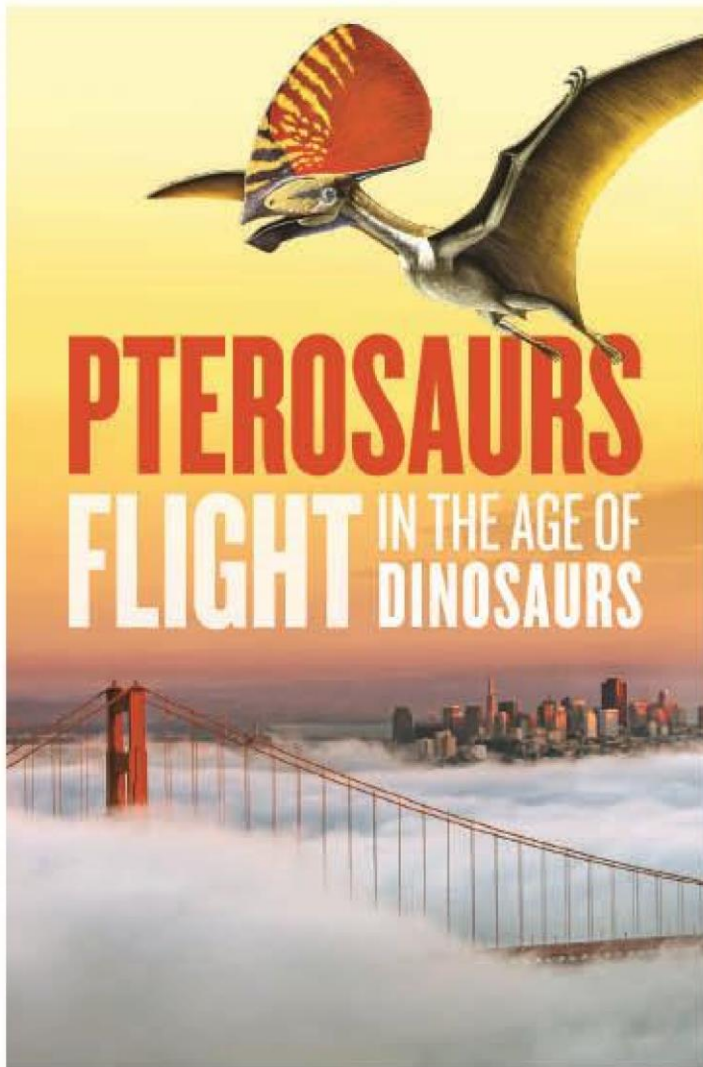

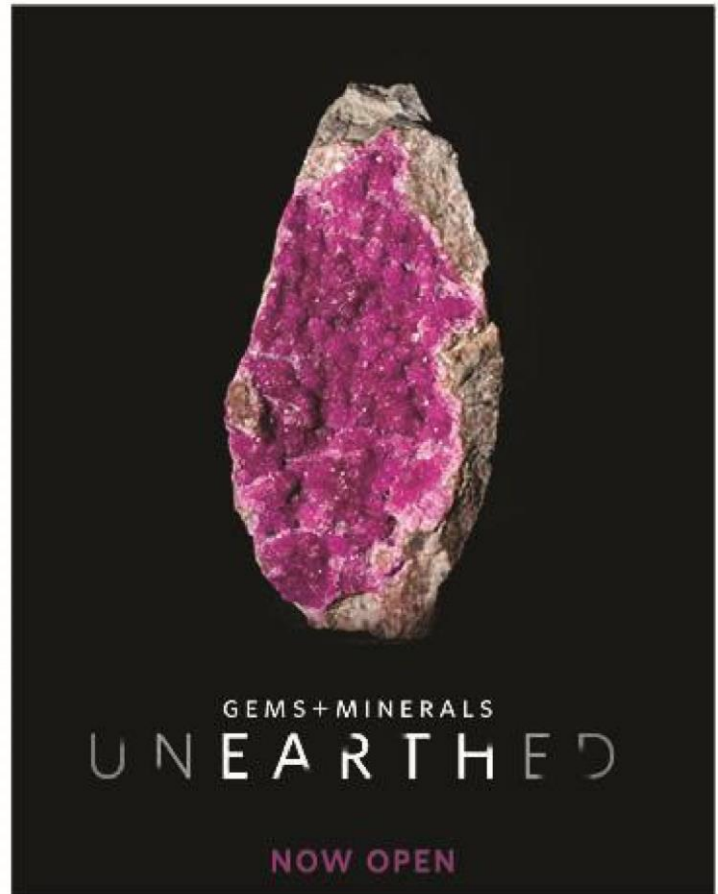

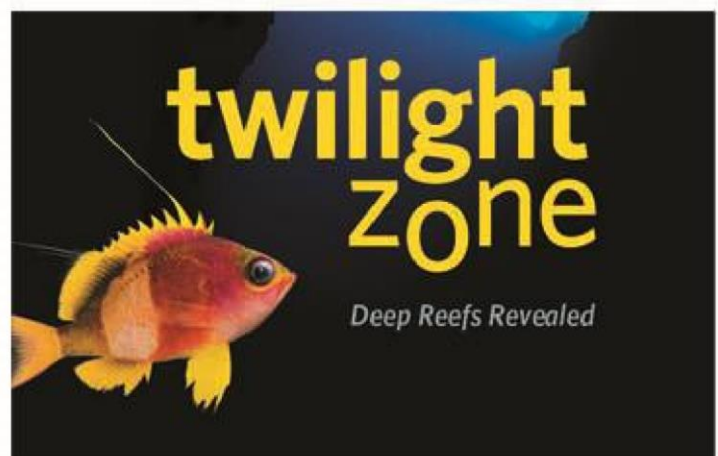
Pterosaurs: Flight in the Age of Dinosaurs Opening May 19, 2017 to January 7, 2018

For as long as dinosaurs walked the Earth, flying animals called pterosaurs ruled the skies. Not birds, not bats, not dinosaurs — these extraordinary winged reptiles adapted for life in the air and were the first vertebrates to evolve powered flight. In the California Academy of Sciences' revealing new exhibit, explore rare fossils and discover the amazing diversity and evolution of these ancient creatures.
