Assembly Bill 2878, co-sponsored by California State PTA and co-authored by Assembly Member Rocky Chavez and Assembly Member Kevin McCarty, has passed through the Assembly and the Senate through a bipartisan vote and is waiting on the governor's desk to be signed into law.

AB 2878 would put researched-based family engagement guidance and practice into California Education Code. <u>Learn more here.</u>




