### Business of the Association

California State PTA delegates representing PTAs from around the state adopted a resolution and revisions to the organization's Legislation Platform at the 2022 Convention. Resolutions come from our members and call attention to a need for action on a particular issue. Adopted resolutions are a major source of authority for California State PTA and its units, councils, and districts in advocating for our children and families locally and at the state capitol. The Legislation Platform is a reflection of the priorities that guide our efforts to secure adequate laws to advance the welfare and protect the rights of our children, youth and families.

#### RESOLUTION: PLANT-BASED FOOD OPTIONS AT SCHOOL MEALS

The adoption of this resolution signals California State PTA's commitment to advocating for and encouraging school efforts to provide equitable access to nutritious meals, decrease detrimental health effects to children, and reduce negative impacts on climate change through food available at schools. California State PTA supports providing a plant-based meal option for all school meals offered.

#### LEGISLATION PLATFORM

Recently adopted changes to California State PTA's Legislation Platform highlight the organization's commitment to creating inclusive and equitable schools and communities that honor diversity. Newly adopted priorities include advocating for a full and culturally responsive curriculum, elevating the student voice, ensuring access to broadband internet service, and requiring state and local government to disseminate information in the language(s) of the community it serves.
















#### ANNA KING, NATIONAL PTA PRESIDENT
