EQUAL ACCESS TO SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS

Adopted by Convention Delegates May 1983 Reviewed by Board of Managers January 2013

WHEREAS, The California State PTA encourages its membership to identify the problems

affecting our schools and offer positive and practical solutions to correct those

problems*; and

WHEREAS, School Improvement Program funds are not now available to all school

districts and all school sites; and

WHEREAS, Children who reside in those districts or who attend those school sites

currently excluded from School Improvement Program funds are being denied

an equal opportunity for a quality education; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the California State PTA urge the state Legislature to enact immediately

legislation that would insure the continuation of School Improvement

Program funds for all school districts and all grades at each school site for the

benefit of every child (K-12) in California public schools.

BACKGROUND SUMMARY

Although districts are approaching a uniform level of "revenue limit" per student before "categorical" income is added, the inaccessibility of School Improvement Program funds for some school districts and some school sites is one of the factors which create a disparity in the amount of money available per student for educational programs.
