

Proposed Bylaws Amendment: VIII-OFFICERS

Article VIII, Section 3 –	
Proposed Amendment: To amend Article VIII, Section 3, by inserting the words “or appointed” after the word “elected” and before the word “State.”	
Current Version	Proposed Version
Section 3 (second paragraph) A person who has served two consecutive terms as an elected State officer shall not be eligible to another elective office until the expiration of at least one term. This provision shall not apply to the offices of president or president-elect.	Section 3 (second paragraph) A person who has served two consecutive terms as an elected or appointed State officer shall not be eligible to another elective office until the expiration of at least one term. This provision shall not apply to the offices of president or president-elect.
Rationale: <i>This addition is to provide consistency by indicating that both elected and appointed State officers are treated the same in terms of eligibility for another elective office.</i>
