Impact Teen Drivers (ITD) conducts [Train the Trainers](#) (TTT) workshops for health and safety partners across the United States—pivoting to online programming at the commencement of the pandemic. TTT workshops share the definition and scope of reckless and distracted driving, current traffic safety research, and best practices for reaching their communities. Participants are provided with evidence-based tools to deliver high-energy presentations focused on the dangers of reckless and distracted driving, becoming well-versed in our evidence-based teen programs, *What Do You Consider Lethal?* and, *Are We Living in a Dream World?*.

Are your presentations graphic or gory?

None of our presentations include graphic or gory content. Research shows that emotional appeal has more influence over teens’ long-term behavior than graphic gore, so Impact Teen Drivers connects with teens on a visceral level by using stories of real teens and their families.
